

WHO WAS CARLO ACUTIS?

Carlo Acutis was a Catholic teenager born

in 1991 in London and raised in Milan. From a young age, he showed a deep love for the Eucharist, daily Mass, and the Rosary. He was also a talented computer programmer who used his skills to evangelize online.

WHAT IS HE KNOWN FOR?

Carlo created a website and a traveling exhibit that cataloged 187 Eucharistic miracles from around the world. He believed the Eucharist was "the highway to heaven" and inspired many to grow in devotion to Jesus.

WHEN IS HE BEING CANONIZED?

Carlo Acutis will be canonized April 25-27,

2025, becoming the first millennial saint. Pope Francis approved the second miracle needed for sainthood in 2023.

WHAT MIRACLES ARE ATTRIBUTED TO HIS INTERCESSION?

Mattheus Vianna:

A Brazilian boy with a rare pancreatic disorder was miraculously healed after prayers to Carlo.

Valeria Valverde:

A Costa Rican teen miraculously recovered from a near-fatal brain injury after her mother visited Carlo's tomb and prayed for his intercession.
