#### 1890

Born on October 16th in Corinaldo, Italy. She was the third of seven children. Her father instilled in her a deep love for God and the Catholic Church.

## 1900

When her father died, she took on household duties and cared for her younger siblings. Her mother, Assunta, struggled to support the family.





#### 1902

The Goretti family shared a small house with another family. Maria fiercly refused the advances of their teenage son, Alessandro, and he stabbed her multile times. Maria died a day later.

## 1934

Pope Pius XII, before a crowd of 250,000, declared Maria Goretti a Saint. Both Maria's mother and Allessandro were present at the canonization.
