Message from the **President** Christopher Check




When I look at the title of our new book *How to Talk About Jesus with Anyone*, co-authored by Cy Kellett and Steve Dawson, I can't help but wonder, "How is it that Catholic Answers did not release such a book decades ago?" For nearly half a century (Catholic Answers turns 50 in 2029), we have poured our hearts into helping ordinary Catholics speak with greater clarity, confidence, and charity about the Catholic faith. Every radio show, every book, every article, every public lecture, every course, every podcast, every social media post, in fact everything we produce exists for one purpose: to help people know Jesus Christ, and to help them bring others to him.

But none of that work is meant to stop at information.

The real work of Catholic Answers happens when a listener shares an episode with a friend in crisis...when a parent answers a child's honest question...when someone invites a fallen-away Catholic back to Mass... when a young man or woman, searching late at night, finds the truth and has the courage to follow it.

That is where you come in. If Catholic Answers has equipped you, I ask you to do one simple thing: pass it on. Send an article, share an episode, invite a friend to explore the faith.

I sometimes call our supporters "force multipliers." Forgive the martial metaphor; my first post out of college was as an artillery officer in the Marine Corps. But it fits: Catholic Answers can produce resources, offer answers, and reach the public square. Yet the mission grows exponentially through the men and women who take what we do, make it their own, and pass it along with love.



We live in an age of chaos and confusion: confusion about the human person, about marriage and family, about the nature of truth itself, and even about God. I know there has been an uptick in OCIA attendance, but it remains a fact that many more are leaving the Catholic Church than entering it. Unbelief is especially prevalent among young people: only four in ten in Gen Z are certain there is a God, and fewer than two in ten attend religious services at least once a week. It's premature to declare, "Mission accomplished!"

But amidst the noise of the world, many are feeling the lack of meaning behind the way they are living, and they are genuinely searching. And this is exactly why Catholic Answers exists.

As you read this annual report, I hope you will see not only milestones and progress, but a deeper story: a growing hunger for truth, and a mission meeting that hunger with clarity and conviction. Because of your prayers and generosity, Catholic Answers is there, day after day, to proclaim the gospel, explain the Faith, and invite people home.

As we approach our fiftieth year, what we are really approaching is our next fifty years.

In the months ahead, we will begin sharing more about a bold, mission-driven initiative designed to strengthen Catholic Answers for the future, so that we can reach more souls, equip more evangelists, and build faithfully for the work God is calling us to do in the years to come.

We are approaching this with prayer, careful discernment, and deep confidence in God's providence.

Our Lord's most terrifying words, perhaps, were "When the Son of Man comes, will he find faith on earth?" (Luke 18:8). If that does not shake you out of your ease, well, go read it again.

Pope Saint Paul VI wrote in *Evangelii Nuntiandi*, "The person who has been evangelized goes on to evangelize others. Here lies the test of truth, the touchstone of evangelization: it is unthinkable that a person should accept the Word and give himself to the kingdom without becoming a person who bears witness to it and proclaims it in his turn."

So yes: let's get to work. Catholic Answers is here to help.

2025 HIGHLIGHTS



New Channels

Along with the growth in YouTube channel views, 2025 saw the launch of new channels, including **Catholic Answers Clips** and **The Cy Kellett Show**. The Clips channel features highlights from *Catholic Answers Live* and has reached more than 2.2 million views. For a deeper dive into a variety of topics, *The Cy Kellett Show* is dedicated to interviews with partners in the vineyard, as well as the monthly *Flannel Panel* shows.



Catholic Answers Live

Our long-standing **Catholic Answers Live** channel also saw significant updates, including more weekly topical shows such as “*Why Aren’t You Catholic?*” and an extended hour with the **Catholic Answers Super Show**. On Tuesdays and Thursdays this year, from 2:00 to 3:00 p.m (PT), viewers can join a live stream featuring conversation, current events, and appearances by other staff members.

Calendar

Each year, Catholic Answers shares a themed calendar with all its supporters, spreading truth, goodness, and beauty through sacred art. The **2025 Catholic Answers Calendar** marked something entirely new by sourcing classical works from living contemporary Catholic artists. We continued this showcase of modern art in 2026 with the theme *Ave Maria: Titles and Apparitions of Our Lady*



Service Awards

For more than forty years, Catholic Answers has been reaching souls. The work of spreading the Gospel has been blessed by the faithful service of longtime staff members who have been with the apostolate for much of its tenure. This year, we honored thirty years of service from **Philip Lenahan**, chief financial officer; twenty-five years from **Kerry Beck**, marketing manager; and twenty years from **Darin DeLozier**, radio producer, and **Tim Staples**, senior apologist. Catholic Answers also welcomed five new staff members this year, bringing expertise in marketing, studios, and customer service.





Parish Partners program

Our **Parish Partner program** continues to grow, with more than 150 ambassadors. In 2025, parish book sales increased by 53 percent thanks to this direct outreach. We are now reaching more souls in parishes through **Flocknote**, which for the first time offers a full Catholic Answers library of resources that parish bulletin editors can tap into to add faith-knowledge to their parish email communications.



Interior Life of the Catholic Answers Staff

The interior life of the staff is essential to the work of the apostolate. Throughout the workday, staff members gather for the Liturgy of the Hours, the Divine Mercy Chaplet, Eucharistic Adoration, and daily Mass. In 2025, our hybrid office was given two new opportunities to strengthen communal prayer. For the first time, staff participated in Lenten and Advent **book studies** leading up to our biannual retreats. This year also marked the beginning of weekly **Monday Morning Convocations**. The Monday gathering opens the week with a spiritual reflection led by apologists and other staff members, connecting the staff to the saints, Church teaching, spiritual reading, and areas of interest.

EWTN Catholic Radio Conference Welcome Reception



LOOKING AHEAD THE MISSION CONTINUES TO GROW

As Catholic Answers continues to expand its outreach, our events are growing in both scope and impact—creating new opportunities for Catholics to encounter Christ more deeply and to boldly share the Faith with the world.

Vineyard Partner Lenten Retreat (March 2026)

In March 2026, Catholic Answers will host our first-ever Vineyard Partner Lenten Retreat at the Heritage Retreat Center in Georgia. This weekend will be a time of prayer and renewal and a special opportunity to thank and deepen our partnership with generous Vineyard Partner supporters.

Counsel of Trent: Online Evangelism Conference — Dallas (April 2026)

Catholic Answers will host the Counsel of Trent: Online Evangelism Conference in Dallas—a one-day event equipping Catholics to share the faith in the digital age. Speakers include Trent Horn, Lila Rose, Joe Heschmeyer, Brian Holdsworth, and more than twenty Catholic creators from YouTube, Instagram, and TikTok.

Catholic Answers on the Rhine (May 2–14, 2026)

Catholic Answers is hosting a twelve-night Rhine River cruise pilgrimage aboard an exclusive charter of the *AmaSiena*, traveling from Amsterdam to Basel. This journey will include daily Mass and on-board talks with **Christopher Check, Joe Heschmeyer, and Cy Kellett**.

Australia (October 1–3, 2026)

In October 2026, **Tim Staples** is scheduled to appear in Perth, Western Australia, as part of an international speaking engagement in partnership with Evangelisation Australia—equipping Catholics to better understand and defend their faith through apologetics.

Catholic Answers in Rome (November 2026)

Catholic Answers staff will guide a pilgrimage through Rome, visiting major spiritual and historical sites including the four major basilicas and the Roman Forum. The journey features daily Mass, time with our apologists, and memorable experiences from the Scavi Tour beneath the Vatican to landmarks like the Spanish Steps and Trevi Fountain.

British Isles Pilgrimage (June 2027)

Catholic Answers is preparing a 2027 pilgrimage through the British Isles, blending travel with daily Mass, Confession, and teaching from our apologists. Planned highlights include the last remaining Templar chapel in London, Trinity College Library in Dublin, and historic sites in Cork and beyond. Join us in 2027.

A Life Changed Forever

James's Story

James was born in the 1990s into a Church of England household in the UK. His mother, who had not grown up in a religious home, began attending church on her own at just eight years old, a quiet yet formative decision that would shape the faith environment of James's childhood.

James attended a Catholic primary school, where he was introduced to the Mass, though at the time he did not understand the theological differences between the Church of England and the Catholic Church. The Christianity he encountered was simple and moralistic: be a good person, and you'll go to heaven.

In the UK, openly embracing religion was not easy. Bullying and social prejudice often awaited those who remained faithful through their youth, and James watched as many people around him gradually drifted away from the Church. For a long time, he resisted doing the same. But as he entered his teenage years, outside social influences eventually pulled him



away from his Christian faith. He began to believe that he didn't need faith to be good or to be saved. His prayer life slowly diminished until it disappeared altogether.

At university, everything changed. James developed a deep fear of death and a heightened awareness of life's fragility. Alongside this came a crippling sense of guilt. He felt compelled to repay evil with good, but the more he tried, the more futile it seemed, as though the debt he carried was infinite. He later described this period as living under an unbearable weight: "*I'm in crippling moral debt.*"

Eventually, a family friend near his university invited him to attend a Baptist church. For the first time in years, faith began to feel real again, and the weight he had been carrying finally started to lift.

Yet new struggles soon emerged. James felt torn between faith and evolution, and between Scripture and the prevailing Western moral framework, particularly around sexuality. While he came to believe the Bible was truly the Word of God, deeper questions followed, like *How do we know which books belong in the Bible?*

This question and others stayed with him for nearly a decade and forced him to confront the seriousness of religion. He came to realize that faith was not merely one question among many, it was *the* question of life.

Eventually, James encountered the writings of Clement of Rome on apostolic succession and Ignatius of Antioch on the Real Presence of the Eucharist. Around the same time, he came across anti-Catholic claims online, which prompted him to deliberately seek out Catholic voices. That search led him to Catholic Answers.

After discovering *Jimmy Akin's Mysterious World*, James soon became a regular listener of *Catholic Answers Live*. The more he explored the Catholic Church, the more convinced he became of its truth. Questions that had troubled him for years finally found coherent, satisfying answers.

In 2023, as the Church of England began approving blessings for same-sex marriages, James briefly considered returning to a Baptist church. Instead, he found himself drawn more deeply into the Catholic Church.

"The books and resources from Catholic Answers have been a real lifeline," James says. Although his RCIA journey was challenging, he credits Catholic Answers with giving him the knowledge and confidence to persevere in pursuit of Truth.

James was received into the Catholic Church at Easter 2024 at the same parish connected to the Catholic primary school he had attended as a child. That summer, he went on pilgrimage to Lourdes, where he had a profound experience that felt like a call to the priesthood. He attributes Catholic Answers with helping him understand the distinct role and nature of the priesthood, allowing him to begin this discernment journey.

James's conversion did not end with him, however; it also transformed his family. His mother entered the Catholic Church alongside him, deeply inspired by his faith journey.

Looking back, James sees Catholic Answers as the bridge that made his conversion possible, preparing him intellectually, strengthening him spiritually, and giving him the confidence to walk into a Catholic parish ready to come home. His story is just one of many examples of the beautiful work made possible through your support.






